Announcements Training Fellowships

Fellowship announcement

The European Society of Surgical Oncology (ESSO) Education and Training Committee (ETC) selected nine international fellows to visit top EU and Non-EU professional centres outside of their home territory to accentuate their knowledge and skills in their individual sub specialty of surgical oncology (hepatobiliary, thoracic, breast, pancreatic, head & neck, skin, melanoma, gynaecology, urology and sarcoma). In 2018 the major training fellowship of 6.000 euros was awarded to Gijs Van Boxel, from Oxford University Hospital (UK) to visit the University Medical Centre of Utrecht (NL). A further eight training fellowships valued collectively at 12.000 euros were divided to Orestis Ioannidis, Olalekan Olasehinde, Slava Kopetskvi, Anastasios Angelou, Tapan Singh Chauhan, Saket Kumar, Mariana Morales and Ramya Yethadka.

In addition, the ESSO Young Surgeons and Alumni Club (EYSAC) grants an annual standard research fellowship of 1.500 euros for a training period of 1–3 months, the most recent of which was given to Serdar Yormaz who will visit Heidelberg University (DE) in 2019.

Applications for 2019 are now open and close the 31st of October 2019. In order to apply you must be a specialist trainee or junior doctor with a declared intention of specialising in a sub specialty of surgical oncology mentioned above. Applicants must be younger than forty years of age and must be a member of ESSO in good standing (applications from non-members will not be considered). Both European & non-European citizens can apply (non-EU citizens must seek to apply in an EU member country).
