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
### Chest x-ray quiz

### Question

This is an anterior-to-posterior (AP) view of a 58 year-old man with hypertension, type 1 diabetes mellitus and coronary artery disease. He underwent coronary by-pass graft surgery four weeks prior. He came to Emergency because of fevers, chills and a general feeling of lethargy. His temperature was 38.8<sup>o</sup>C. There was some chest wall tenderness along both sides of his sternum. He did say that he had felt a “clicking” sensation in his chest during the last week. What is notable on this patient’s chest x-ray?
