



Call for Papers: Emergencies in Radiology: Pediatric to Adult

The Journal of Radiology Nursing is planning a special issue in 2020 on emergencies in the radiology department for pediatric to adult groups.

Sample topics:

- Contrast reactions
- Periprocedural stroke
- Periprocedural cardiac arrest
- Sedation complications
- Pneumothorax after lung biopsy
- Vessel dissection, iatrogenic, carotid, AAA, or other
- Device issues: breakage, migration, failure
- Contrast extravasation
- Malignant hyperthermia
- Complications of angiography: retroperitoneal hematoma, loss of pulses, distal embolization
- Failure of fluoroscopy to stop during procedure
- In-hospital disasters (communication breakdown, fire, etc.)
- Staff response, debriefing after adverse events: talking to the patient/family
- Needlestick injury
- Managing transfusion reactions
- Anticoagulation issues
- Acute pain management
- Vasospasm management
- Periprocedural hyper/hypotension
- Staffing shortage or critical leadership issues
- Violence in the radiology department
- MRI incidents or near misses
- Patient fall with injuries
- Seizure management update
- Rapid response teams
- Root cause analysis

We are seeking original research and review manuscripts (4000 words), case studies (1000-1500 words), and short communications (1000-1500 words). Authors should submit an abstract, 3-5 keywords, and several highlights with the paper. Authors also may include links to websites, video demonstrations, images, forms, documents, or figures. Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reuse copyrighted material.
