The Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics Call for Abstracts

The Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics is requesting abstracts, biographical sketches, and a digital photograph for the Society's Annual Graduate Research Competition, cosponsored by *The Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry*. Current prosthodontic residents at UCLA, Loma Linda University, UCSF, University of Washington, Veterans Administration at Los Angeles, USC, and the University of British Columbia are eligible to apply. Oral presentations of 10 minutes can range from a topic of original research to a clinical/technique review. It is the intent of this

program for a manuscript to be submitted to *The Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry* following the competition. A \$1750 first prize, \$1250 second prize, and \$1000 third prize will be awarded for the best three presentations. This year's meeting will be held at the Rancho Bernardo Inn in San Diego, California. To defray traveling and lodging expenses, a stipend will be awarded to each candidate selected for the competition. To qualify for consideration, abstracts must be submitted by March 1, 2020.
