ABOUT DR CARLO MARINELLO

Dr Marinello is a Professor Emeritus of the University of Basel and former President of the American Prosthodontic Society. He has taught for several prestigious university programs at the University of Basel and University of Gothenburg, as well as the University of Zurich where he served as the Head of Periodontology, Department of Preventive Dentistry, Periodontology and Cariology. He holds a Distinguished Lecturer Award from the American College of Prosthodontics and from the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics. Dr Marinello earned his dental degree from the University of Zurich and a Master of Science degree from the University of Gothenburg.
