Congratulations to the 2018 NYRS Monthly Meeting Quiz Winners



Since 2013, Clinical Imaging has served as the official journal of New York Roentgen Society (NYRS). Founded in 1912 to address not only the scientific advancements but also the clinical challenges of the rather young specialty of radiology, NYRS flourished as it offered a forum for discussion and drew leaders in the field of radiological sciences including honorary memberships by Dr. Wilhelm Roentgen (1914) and Dr. Marie Curie (1921). Opening its doors to members in training, NYRS began to hold monthly educational meetings covering topics of major radiologic and radiation oncologic subspecialties which kicked off with a friendly competitive subspecialty resident quiz around 2005.

A welcome monthly Monday afternoon tradition in most of New York area training institutions is the early exodus of residents from reading rooms to decipher 10 diagnostic imaging unknowns for a chance to claim the win. Winners of the quiz are announced at the end of the meeting, with 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners as well as a junior resident champion. "Participating in the monthly NYRS quizzes challenged me to overcome my fear of the unknown and the prospect of failure. Every opportunity to fail also presents a chance at success. I am glad I took my chances and succeeded. I am also less fearful of the unknown and I know more now than I did before," said Dr. Abimbola Ayoola, NYU resident class of 2018, and three-time first place 2017 NYRS winner. Dr. Robert Min, Chairman of the Department of Radiology, Weill Cornell at New York Presbyterian, further added that the monthly educational meetings are "not only a great educational forum but a wonderful opportunity for healthy com-


