The authors regret that in the Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale, there has been incorrect interpretations due to reversed scores. We reported that 58 young adults (76%) had low self-esteem and that 18 young adults (24%) had normal self-esteem, but the correct scores should be that 15 young adults (20%) had low self-esteem and 61 young adults

(80%) had normal to high self-esteem. We would like to correct this error. The Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale is one of many scales used in the study and the conclusion of the study will remain the same.
