The authors deeply regret that we have discovered an error was made in the Material and methods section, Results section and table 2 of this paper:

The second sentence in the Material and methods section:

‘We performed 123 delayed breast reconstructions using a propeller TAP flap in 94 patients of age 51 years (range: 26-71 years) between August 2011 and September 2017.’ should be corrected as follows:

‘We performed 123 delayed breast reconstructions using a propeller TAP flap in 109 patients of age 51 years (range: 26-71 years) between August 2011 and September 2017.’

The first sentence in the results section:

‘We performed the described procedure 123 times, in 65 unilateral and 29 bilateral cases.’ should be corrected as follows:

‘We performed the described procedure 123 times, in 95 unilateral and 14 bilateral cases’

Table 2, second and third line:

Reconstruction: Unilateral 65

Bilateral 29 should be corrected as follows:

Reconstruction: Unilateral 95

Bilateral 14

The mistake does not influence other results in the paper, since all results were calculated by breast and not by patient except for mean operation time, and the correct values were used for this calculation. We have been through all other results and there were no other errors. The mistake has slipped in during table formation and no good explanation for this can be found!
