The labels of Preferred language were reversed in all three columns (overall, male and female); the row for English shows the percentages for those who preferred Spanish and vice versa. The correct percentages of adults who preferred Spanish are 70.3%, 64.8% and 75.2% for overall, males and females respectively.
