The editorial office has been informed of errors in the Results section of the main text. Three values in the text were not updated after re-analysis and do not match Table 2. The values are correct in Table 2.

The changes are to the following sentence: “Among men, the prevalence of cigarette smoking was 27.0% for those who identified as gay and 25.9% for those who identified as bisexual, compared with 21.3% for those who identified as straight (Table 2).” The values should read as 26.1%, 20.7%, and 20.5% respectively.
