


**Fig. 1** Evolution of the pelvis and hips. Anteroposterior (AP) radiograph of the pelvis

Imaging at different ages of a 4-year-old boy referring for diffuse joint stiffness and progressive bilateral visual impairment (Figs. 1, 2 and 3).


