### Special issue on nursing workforce and work environment

To meet the high demand of increasing aging population and entire population, the steady expansion of medical services promotes the fight on a limited pool of local nurses for general hospitals, community hospitals, and nursing homes. Effective human resource planning, management, and development could ensure a balance between the supply and demand of nurse human resources, thereby leading to national self-sustainability. This Special Focus Issue welcomes original research papers, evidence-based localization pilot study, perspectives, conceptual papers, case reports, systematic review, and scoping review articles that focus on nursing workforce and work environment. We encourage research and practices to address a range of topics including, but not limited to, the following areas:

- Current situation regarding the shortages and mobility/migration of nurses in your country
- Enforcement of a reasonable nurse-to-patient ratio, including practices to promote legislation and health insurance payments, or reports about patients' outcomes affected by the nurse-to-patient ratio
- Exploration of metrics to measure nurse workload and work difficulty or complexity
- Nurses post management, including positions from nurse leader to assistant nurse
- Promotion of positive practice environments, safe work environment, flexible work arrangements, and culture environment
- Standardized training program for newly recruited nurses or expansion of the scope of training system for nurses to perform specific medical interventions.

- Promotion of nursing professions' recruitment and retention
