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## **Supporting Political Advocacy in the Emergency Department**

Physicians should be free to exercise their personal and professional judgment in voting, speaking, and advocating on any matter in regard to patient care interests, the profession, health care in the community, and the independent exercise of



medical judgment. Physicians should not be deemed in breach of their employment agreements, nor be retaliated against by their employers, for asserting these interests.\*
